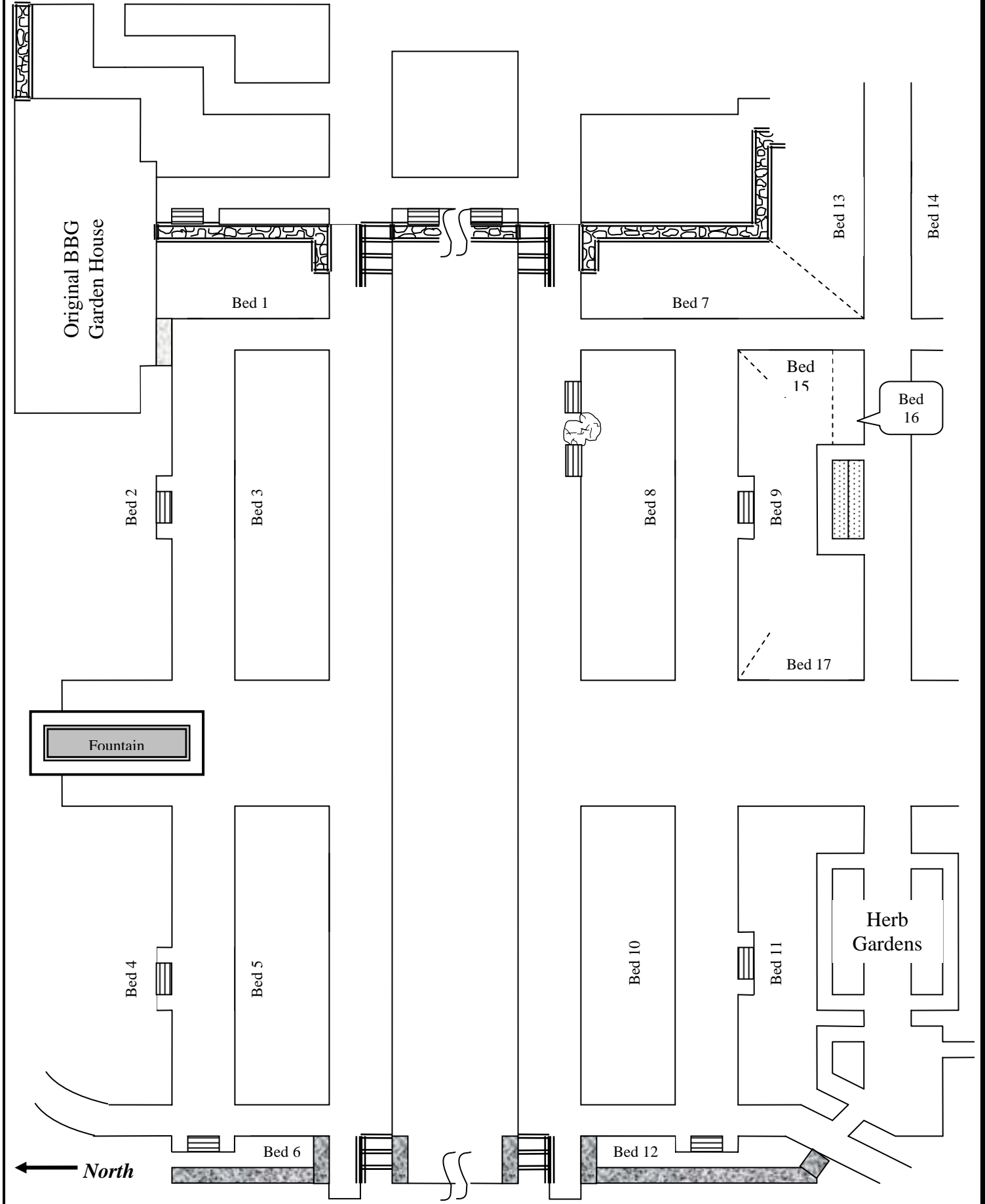

Location of the Iris Garden

The "Iris Garden" consists of about 30 standard dwarf bearded irises planted just to the north of the Daylily Garden. Boerner does not consider this to be a separate garden. To find this "garden", go to the Daylily Path. Sit down on the bench just east of the restrooms. You are looking at the Iris Garden. The irises are on the east side of the daylily path.

p	perennial
b	bulb
w	woody shrub, tree, vine

<u>Bloom Codes (lower case)</u>	
e	First flower: The first flowers are completely open. You can see the stamens among the unfolded petals.
x	Full flower: At least 50% of the flowers are fully opened.
p	Past bloom: Flowers are still colorful but generally fading.
c	Cut down: Trimmed by horticulturist or rabbits/deer
