Bloom Codes for Perennial Gardens 2007

- e** = Early blooms or pretty buds
- x** = Full bloom
- p** = Past their prime, but still colorful
- r** = Rebloom
- c** = Cut by horticulturist or eaten by deer/rabbits

Location code (left)

- e** or **w** = East or west side of bed
- n** or **s** = North or south side of bed
- m** = Middle of bed (usually near bench or marker 50)
- b** = Both sides of bed (2 plants)

Location code (right)

- f** = Front of bed
- m** = Middle of bed
- b** = Back of bed

Example of some location codes

- wf** = West side of bed in the front
- bb** = Both sides of bed and in the back

Code (Col. 5)

- nl** = No label in bed, but on map
- ad** = Added to map after Oct 2007
